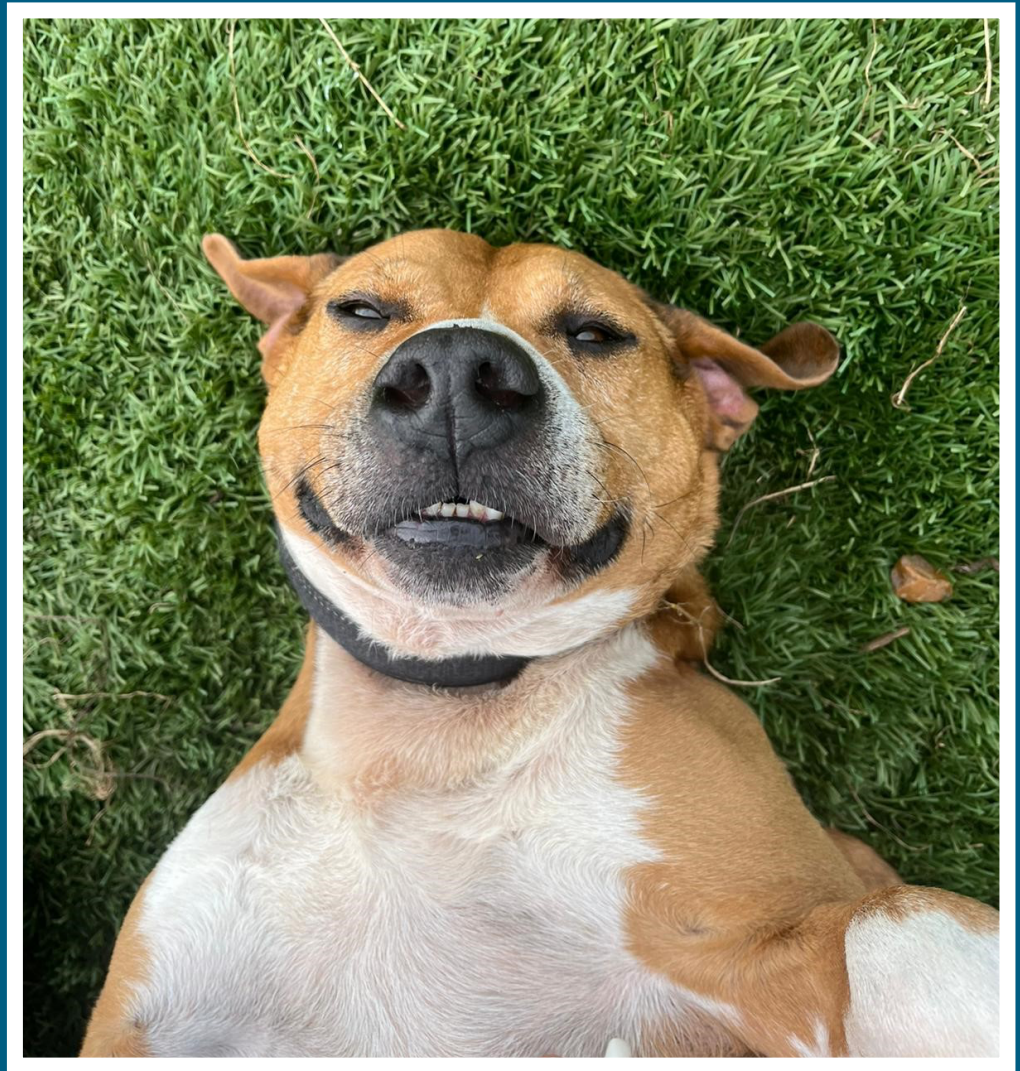

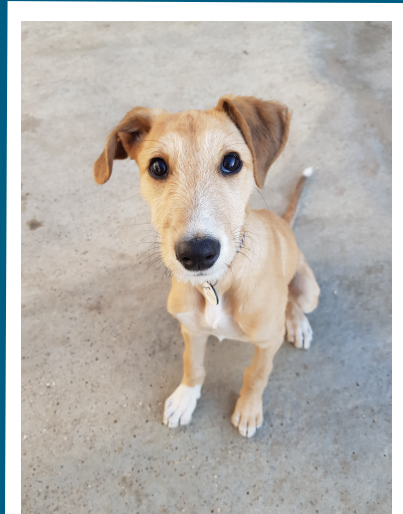
## Your Will

Making or changing a Will is an important step and we recommend getting a solicitor to draw up your Will. They will also be able to give you advice on the best type of legacy to meet your wishes and your circumstances, and whether your gift may reduce inheritance tax liability.

## Types of Legacy

The main types of legacy are where you leave a specific item, where you leave a specific sum, or where you leave your remaining estate, or a share of it, after your debts, estate administration costs and taxes, along with any specific legacies have been paid).

The suggested wording for leaving a sum of money is *"I give the sum of £... to Dog Trouble Foundation, Heathlands Road, Wokingham, RG40 3AP, Community Interest Company number 11623034, absolutely for its general charitable purposes and the receipt of the proper officer of Dog Trouble Foundation shall be a good and sufficient discharge to my executors."*
